### **Course Syllabus**

**Course Description:** This course is a 36-week course entitled Bible Truths “Themes from the Old Testament”. This course covers the Old Testament using different methods of Bible study (word study, chapter analysis, book overview or topical approach) to highlight key themes in selected passages. In this way the student is exposed not only to the broad range of Old Testament material but also to the different ways of approaching that material for maximum application and spiritual benefit. Scripture verse memory work will also be incorporated from the NKJV Bible as well as critical writing and projects. In addition, students will be required to keep and maintain a class notebook/ binder with all completed assignments and assessments.

**Major Topics:** Messages from Prose, Messages from Poetry, Messages from Prophecy

### **Required Materials:**
