

5 Steps to Dual Enroll at TCA

We are excited to let you know that TCA will be offering dual enrollment classes to our 11th and 12th grade students who meet eligibility requirements (Southeastern University approval, minimum 3.0 GPA and teacher/administration recommendation).



Trinity Christian Academy offers concurrent college credit through a partnership with Southeastern University (SEU), a Christian university located in Lakeland, Florida. The dual-credit courses are taught by our faculty on our campus during the regular school day, but credit is awarded for successful completion of the course by Southeastern University. Because SEU is an accredited school, these credits can be transferred to a large number of other colleges and universities as well as automatically accepted by SEU. However, it is your family's responsibility to make sure that the colleges and universities that your student is considering would accept the classes for college credit.

Below are 5 steps that will guide your student and family in this process:

1. *Meet initial GPA requirement of 3.0 (Juniors and Seniors)*
2. *Choose a dual enrollment course on the elective form and submit to Mr. Brown via email or turn into the front office by July 26, Thursday.*
3. *Complete online application with Southeastern University (SEU) by July 30 and get approved*

4. *Get TCA approval for dual enrollment (administration and instructor approval required)*
5. *Pay \$25 dual enrollment fee and textbook cost by September 1st*
